Agriculture and Food in the Indian Ocean Territories

The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development — Agriculture and Food provides 6 broad services on behalf of the Australian Government:

- advice that supports agricultural development in the Territories;
- agricultural development services that provide licensing, brands, permit and regulatory approvals;
- horticultural advice and services that investigate opportunities to expand commercial horticulture;
- animal welfare services;
- biosecurity services; and
- general advice on weed, pest and production support through the Pest and Disease Information Service.

What does this mean for me?

The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development — Agriculture and Food provides advice and regulatory support to assist the development of agricultural enterprises in the Territories. The aim is to encourage the economic growth of the Territories by growing markets, productivity and profitability, while boosting biosecurity and sustaining natural resources.



The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development primarily provides biosecurity services to the Indian Ocean Territories. The Department has the ability to provide horticultural advice and services, animal welfare services, and agricultural development services within capacity and resources.
