Corrective Services in the Indian Ocean Territories

The Department of Justice — Corrective Services provides the following services on behalf of the Australian Government:

- provide for adult offenders and young people who offend, management services that protect the community;
- give adult offenders and young people who offend, the interventions they need to make a positive difference in their lives and reduce their involvement in the criminal justice system;
- support adult offenders and young people who offend to become responsible citizens by adopting law-abiding lifestyles; and
- promote crime prevention.

What does this mean for me?

The safety of your community is protected through the Department of Justice — Corrective Services and offenders are supported in their rehabilitation.



Youth Justice Services (YJS) is responsible for the safety, security and rehabilitation of young people in custody and those engaged with YJS in the community. The work of YJS is informed by the principles of the applied [Young Offenders Act 1994 \(WA\)](#); in doing so it places the young person at the centre of everything it does. YJS coordinates supports from families, communities, government and non-government agencies to address the complex needs of young people, diverting them away from the criminal justice system to live law-abiding lifestyles.
