What does this mean for me?

By using the library services, Territories residents have access to:

- 2,835,000 public library materials and over 55,000 electronic resources at no cost through the state-wide library network;
- new library materials delivered to the libraries on a regular basis;
- a range of eResources available for use at home together with eBooks, eAudio and eMagazines;
- a Better Beginnings reading pack for every baby born; and
- a second Better Beginnings reading pack provided to all 4 year olds and their families.



The library supports literacy for children by providing them with greater potential to grow, learn and develop, perform well at school and succeed later in life.
