## WA Planning Commission in the Indian Ocean Territories

The WA Planning Commission is the lead statutory body responsible for the strategic and statutory land-use planning, land development and infrastructure coordination in the Territories. The planning system in the Territories also involves the Australian Government, the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage, and local governments, as well as developers and landowners.

### What does this mean for me?

The WA Planning Commission's role is prescribed in the applied [Planning and Development Act 2005 \(WA\)](#) and includes:

- providing advice to the Commonwealth Minister on land use planning, land development and infrastructure coordination;
- preparation, monitoring and review of land use planning policies, schemes, strategies and plans;
- planning for the coordinated provision of infrastructure; and
- regulating integrated land-use planning through land use and statutory planning controls and approvals.



The WA Planning Commission will take a lead role in shaping the future of the Territories in a sustainable manner by supporting integrated strategic and statutory land use planning, land development and infrastructure coordination.
