What does this mean for me?

The Department of Water and Environmental Regulation's key role is to deliver quality advice and services to the Environmental Protection Authority and government to support the protection of the environment. This is done by supporting the Environmental Protection Authority in the consideration of:

- x the referrals of schemes and scheme amendments
- x provision of advice and conducting environmental impact assessment of schemes and scheme amendments
- x supporting the Environmental Protection Authority to provide reports to the Australian Government Minister on appeals received in respect of a scheme or scheme amendment
- x supporting the Environmental Protection Authority to provide advice to the Australian Government on significant environmental issues relating to schemes and scheme amendments
- x associated support to the Australian Government if required.
