Topic	Centrepay Option now available		
Relevance	Electricity Accountholders		

Centrepay is a free direct bill-paying service offered to customers receiving payments from Centrelink. In discussions with some accountholders and the Wreck Bay Aboriginal Community Council (WBACC) it had been suggested that the Jervis Bay Territory Administration (Administration) offer the Centrepay option for electricity accountholders.

Centrelink has approved the Jervis Bay Territory Administration as a registered organisation with Centrepay.


Through Centrepay you can choose to pay your electricity account by having a regular amount (minimum \$10 per fortnight) deducted from your Centrelink payment.

Electricity accountholders, who choose the Centrepay option, will benefit from knowing that their payments are under control. Instead of having large electricity bills every two months their account will be paid in manageable amounts from their Centrelink payment, making it easier for them to budget.

With the first issue of electricity accounts in 2011 the Administration is distributing a leaflet *Manage your Bills for Free – Centrepay*
