This unique program offers participants:

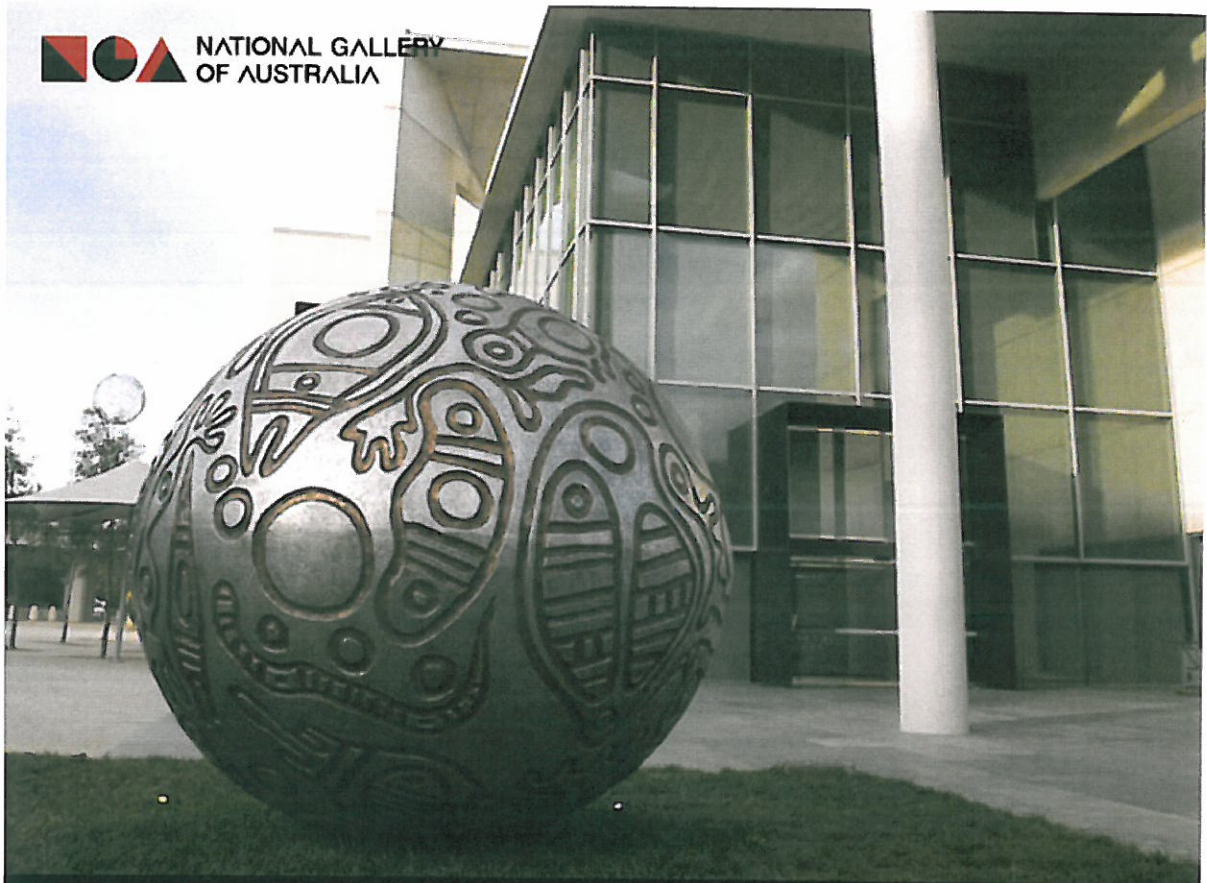
- an insight into the National Gallery of Australia and the largest display of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander art in the world;
