Jervis Bay Territory residents

The Australian Government has arrangements with the Shoalhaven City Council so that Jervis Bay Territory residents have access to library services on the same basis as residents of the Shoalhaven City Council local government area, including the fortnightly visit of the Mobile Library Service.



Joining the library is free on presentation of personal identification.

Members enjoy the following benefits:

- Free borrowing of any items in the lending collections – books, magazines, DVDs, audio and large print books;
- A reservation service for items currently out on-loan;
- Access to inter-library loans; and
- Able to borrow from any of the libraries within the local government areas of Shoalhaven City, Eurobodalla and Kiama.

The Mobile Library parks at the Jervis Bay Village Community Health & Dental Clinic, which is adjacent to the Jervis Bay School, between **11:50 am and 12:50 pm** every second Thursday. Visits for the remainder of 2011 are 3 and 17 November, and 1 and 15 December.

Jervis Bay School classes can borrow up to 20 books per Mobile visit.
