Topic	Trial of public bus service ends on 30 June 2012		

In 2009 the Australian Government, through the Jervis Bay Territory Administration, commenced a 3 year trial of public bus services to/from the Jervis Bay Territory (JBT) and a transport hub at Vincentia.

The public bus service was set-up with the intention of improving access for JBT residents to further training, education and employment opportunities in nearby NSW. It was expected to provide a transport option to facilitate access to specialist services, entertainment and social events. Tourists could also use the public bus service to visit the Booderee National Park.

Over the 3 year trial period, the public bus service has not received the support that was expected from the local community. Due to the very low patronage a decision has been taken **not to extend the trial bus service** beyond 30 June 2012.

Only the public bus services are affected by this decision: the shopping bus (Tuesday and Friday) and student transport services (managed by ACT Education for the JBT Administration) will continue to operate.
