Domestic Animals Fees 2013

The ACT Government has released the *Domestic Animals (Fees) Determination 2013 (No 1)*, which sets the fees and charges for domestic animal transactions in the Jervis Bay Territory.

The new fees were introduced with effect from 1 July 2013.

Below is a list of the most common charges:

Lifetime registration of a dog	\$47.40
Lifetime registration of a dog where keeper is a pension/benefit recipient	\$17.50
Issue of a permit to keep any cat or dog that has not been desexed	\$347.10
Issue of a permit to keep any cat or dog that has not been desexed where keeper is a pension/benefit recipient	\$71.05
Surrendering of dog ownership	\$52.95
